### 2. Certificate of Enrollment

Present your Certificate of Enrollment at the BMV to obtain your Learner's Permit and begin your behind-the-wheel practice!

### 1. Learner's Permit

At 15, you can apply for a Learner's permit if you are enrolled in a driver's education program (good thing you're with All Star).

### 3. Certificate of Completion

Once you complete your online course, we will send you a Certificate of Completion! You can take this to the BMV along with your drive log to apply for a probationary license.

### 4. Probationary License

At 16 and 90 days, you can apply for your probationary license! In addition, you need to have held your learner's permit for at least 6 months. If you are under the age of 18, you will need a Supervised Driving Log and may need a co-signer for financial liability.

### 5. Driver's License

When you turn 21, your license is no longer probationary! You will have 30 days after your 21st birthday in order to renew your license, as the probationary license expires then. Head to the BMV to upgrade your license.

In order to obtain an Indiana ID, you will need proof of the following:

#### Identity & Lawful Status (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 1
- U.S. Passport
  - Original or Certified U.S. Birth Certificate
  - Consular Report of Birth Abroad

#### Social Security (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 2
- Social Security Card
  - W-2 Form
  - SSA-1099

#### Documents proving Indiana residency (2)

Only (2) documents from below required

- 3
- USPS Change of Address Form
  - Voter ID
  - Survey of Property
  - Bank Statement

\*The lists above are the most commonly used documents\*
