## 2. Pick Up Your Permit!

Go to your local Deputy Registrar License Agency to purchase your Temporary Instruction Permit Identification Card within 60 days of passing the vision and written knowledge tests.

Make sure you don't forget the required documents! Don't worry, we've got your back. Check the flipside of this map to make sure you're prepared!

## 1. Knock out your vision and written knowledge tests!

Go to your local Driver Exam Station and complete your vision and written knowledge tests. If you don't pass the first time, you can take it again as soon as 24 hours later.

## 3. Get Behind-The-Wheel!

Your permit grants you the ability to start driving! Register for the behind-the-wheel component of your education with a local, state-certified, professional driving school. Present them with your Online Enrollment Certificate (OEC) to prove that you've started the required classroom hours with All Star.

Remember, you need 8 hours behind-the-wheel with a professional driving school and 50 hours (10 at night) of behind-the-wheel practice with a parent or legal guardian.

## 4. Become an All Star!

When you've finished our course, we will mail you your Online Completion Certificate (OCC). You will need to take that certificate to the school where you did your behind-the-wheel hours and they will present you with a Driver Training Completion Certificate (DT). You need this certificate in order to take the driving test.

## 5. Get Your License!

Now it's time for your driving test! Set up an appointment at the Driver Exam Station to take the test. Don't forget your Driver Training Completion Certificate! If you fail your first try, you'll have to wait 7 days in order to retake the test. After your fourth attempt, you'll need to wait six months in order to retake the test. So, remember, relax and take your time! It's all about state of mind!

To obtain a license you need proof of the following:

Full Legal Name, Date of Birth, & Legal Presence in the US (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 1 U.S. Birth Certificate  
U.S. Passport  
U.S. Passport card

Social Security Number (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 2 Social Security Card  
W-2 Wage/Tax Form  
1099 Income Statement

Ohio Street Address (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 3 Official Business  
Official Government  
Document with Ohio Home Street Address

Additional Documents (1)

Only (1) document from below required

- 4 Learner's Permit, U.S. citizenship and immigration documents, certified copy of court order (1-2), USCIS Document, Naturalization Document (3), medical records, school transcript (4), Ohio concealed weapons permit (5)
